- 1.** There is an old portrait from the 1800's that was misidentified as Sir Isaac Brock featured in the Brock archives. The misidentified portrait is actually this person.

- 2.** A list of officers to receive half-pay in December 1791 is available in the Brock Library archives. Sir Isaac Brock is listed, as well as his brother. Find the name of Sir Isaac Brock's brother.

- 3.** Whose name appears on the cover of the Statues of his Majesty's Province in Upper Canada 1812? Why does his name appear on this cover?
